- Camp sizes are limited. Register early to ensure a spot! Send registration form along with a minimum \$50 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit for each camper before June 1, 2020. (A \$25 late-fee will be added to registrations received June I and later.) Balance due upon arrival. (Discounts or scholarships cannot be applied to deposits. Discounts are not available after June 1).
