June 19-24

Grades 9-12

\$350 (\$375 after June 1)

Even with night games, group hikes and a beach outing, campers are given the freedom to unplug from the distractions that commonly clutter our lives. Campers will be challenged to get comfortable with quiet, make space to listen and to deepen relationships. Cabin groups build community through activities and sharing.

June 26-July 1

Grades 7-8

\$325 (\$350 after June 1)

Field games, nature activities, tubing, and archery are a few of camp's daily adventures. Time to reflect and worship are provided in group settings and individually through chapel, devotions and fireside. The result is a week packed with both fun and personal reflection.

July 1-3

Parent & Me – Grades K-2

\$225 (\$250 after June 1)

Flexible programming provides opportunities for first-time campers to develop independence. Children will sleep in cabins and participate in activities with the comfort of having a loved one nearby. Adults spend quality time with campers and enjoy a break from life's normal responsibilities. Please use a separate form for each child. \$100 for each additional child (sibling discount applied); \$75 for each additional adult.

July 3-8

Grades 5-6

\$325 (\$350 after June 1)

Opportunities will abound for campers to engage in activity! Capture the Flag, the Olympics and 5-puck are some of the favorites, along with cabin activities, worship, chapel, fireside and enjoying the wonders of God's creation in DCC's unique setting.

July 10-15

Grades 3-4

\$325 (\$350 after June 1)

Not quite a week-long camp, campers will have the opportunity to gain independence spending 4 nights in a cabin. Primary grades enjoy days packed with activities, group games, crafts, chapels and firesides balanced with a quiet afternoon rest and earlier bedtime.

Discount & Registration Information

• **Camp sizes are limited.** Register early to ensure a spot! Send registration form along with a minimum \$50 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit for each camper **before** June 1, 2022. (**A \$25 late-fee will be added to registrations received June 1 and later.**) Balance due upon arrival. (Discounts or scholarships cannot be applied to deposits. Discounts are not available after June 1).

• An early-bird discount of \$20 can be applied to registrations post-marked before April 1, 2022.

• Sibling discounts of \$25 per camper can be applied when two or more children from the same family attend. Please submit registrations together.

• Camps will begin at 4 p.m. on the starting day and campers should be picked up by 11:30 a.m. on the final camp day.

• Cabin friend requests will be taken into consideration when assigning cabins. However, the beauty of the camp community is the opportunity to get to know new people and expand friendships. Flexibility is appreciated.

• **Drift Creek Camp is used by rental groups throughout the year and therefore cannot maintain a nut-free kitchen.** If your camper has a food allergy, we ask that you partner with DCC to meet the needs of your child. Please contact Glen (foodservice@driftcreek.org) to plan menu substitutions.

• Financial assistance is available through many churches, consider asking yours to help with camp fees.
