## Not So Mysterious 60" x 60":

This quilt was designed by Joyce, so there is no charge for the pattern. It is a great skill-building class where you'll learn to easily make 4-patches, half-square triangles, square in a square, flying geese and Tri-Recs (aka triangle in a square) units.

Color	60" x 60"
Dark	7/8 yard
Focal (includes border)	1-1/2 yards
Medium (chain)	3/8 yard
Pop (red)	3/8 yard
Background	2-1/2 yards
Binding	5/8 yard

Directions to Drift Creek Camp:

From Lincoln City go south on Hwy. 101. Turn left onto Drift Creek Road and proceed for 2 miles. When you come to the "T" in the road, turn right. Go ¼ mile, and then turn left heading uphill on the less traveled road. You are now on a Forest Service road. Follow the signs at each intersection for "church camp" or "DC Camp." You will travel a total of 11 miles off of Hwy. 101.

1. Sewing machine in good working order (if applicable). Be sure to include presser feet and power cord.

- 6. Rotary ruler
- 7. Seam ripper
- 8. Thread to match project
- 9. Pins

## **Mystery Colors and suggestions:**

Following is what I used on my quilt:

Light	1-3/4 yards	Cream
Medium	2-1/2 yards	Floral
Dark	1-3/4 yards	Navy
Border	1-1/4 yards	Teal
Pop	1/4 yd or FQ	Orange
Binding	3/4 vd	Orange

Please note that you're going to use a lot of medium, so be sure you love it! I recommend using small to medium prints. Tone-on-tone also work well.

Other colors I tried out on my computer – all used a multi-print that tied everything together. My borders were more tone-on-tone:

- · Red, white, blue, gold
- Eggplant, lavender, green, fuchsia
- Cream, grey, black, cheddar or blue
- Consider all shades of one color such as blue
- Tan, red, brown, olive or orange
