SUMMARY

Counselors are responsible to care for the physical and emotional needs of assigned camper groups & facilitate program activities.

RESPONSIBILITIES TO CAMPER:

- Provide a Christ-centered, welcoming atmosphere where campers feel loved and cared for
- Be the hands & feet of Jesus in serving others
- Provide supervision (*along with a co-counselor*) among a group of approximately 10 kids (tasks include setting tables, sweeping the dining area, daily camper check-ins, clean-up and adhering to the schedule)
- Guide cabin group devotion and daily prayer with input from Camp Pastor
- Instill in campers an appreciation for the natural world and a sense of stewardship of God's creation

FACILITY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The transition between camp and rental groups is crucial to operations. Assistance is required from summer staff to ensure the grounds and buildings are prepared for incoming groups.
- Staff meetings will begin around 1pm on Sundays and cleaning after camps will conclude around 4pm. *Counselors are invited to remain on site over weekends.*

- Implement objectives as outlined in the staff manual; abide by camp safety rules
- Participate in staff orientation & staff meetings
- Take part in morning chapel & fireside
- Lead program activity periods (hikes, games, crafts, etc.)

- Ability to work cooperatively
- Good listening and communication skills
- Ability to be impartial
- Ability to provide discipline for campers; not afraid to say no
- Flexibility!
- A genuine interest in working with and caring for children
- Enjoyment of people and enthusiasm for life!
- An understanding of the camp safety and emergency policies
- Be a self motivator, seeing and doing tasks without being asked
- Be self-aware; recognizing how your actions affect others
- Be an initiator in activities
- Bring your all; show your enthusiasm!

COMPENSATION:
